

ENVIRONMENTAL AUDIT AND BASELINE STUDY OF PORT OF DALHOUSIE, NEW BRUNSWICK, CANADA



OCL Group was retained to undertake a detailed environmental audit of all facilities at the Port of Dalhousie, New Brunswick. The facility is comprised of two large wharves, associated lands leased to industrial tenants (including a lead/zinc ore shipment facility and a Bunker C oil receiving facility) and associated water lots within the Restigouche River /estuary. The audit involved review of associated legislation, provincial and federal (Fisheries Act, Canadian Environmental Protection Act, Canadian Environmental Assessment Act, Transport of Dangerous Goods Act and Canadian Shipping Act). Operations both historic and present day were reviewed and recommendations were made regarding requirement for additional data collection as well as operational improvements.
