

DEVELOPMENT OF HAZARDOUS MATERIAL MANAGEMENT PLAN FOR CFB GAGETOWN



OCL Group was retained by Canada Dept. of National Defence (Defence Construction Canada) to evaluate the existing HAZMAT Management System including the inventory system (electronic models used and proposed). An audit of the hazardous materials management was conducted such that a full review of legislation and regulatory requirements was conducted, a review of objectives and targets was initiated and augmented, roles and responsibilities were determined, Training requirements were determined. Procedures were reviewed and changed as necessary, a full hazardous materials management review was conducted. The contract included: ensure legal compliance with Federal hazardous materials regulations, ensure viability of the management system, evaluate the procurement directives and provide recommendations for revisions and/or improvements.

Outcomes included the development of a hazardous material policy and production of a hazardous material management plan.

As part of the planning, a detailed assessment of mercury-containing equipment was completed for submission by DND to Environment Canada.

Training modules for hazardous material management were reviewed for applicability and new training management plans were developed.
