

INDOOR ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY, PRINCE COUNTY HOSPITAL SUMMERSIDE, PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND



OCL Group was retained to investigate IEQ issues throughout the facility, portions of which were built as early as 1922 and as late as 1974. The primary IAQ problem was mould contamination related to plumbing leaks and poorly ventilated shower and bathrooms. Other problems, typical of older buildings, were also identified.

A detailed remedial plan was developed in consultation with the Health Authority and OCL was also retained to supervise/monitor implementation of the Plan. The outcome of the IAQ study led the Health Authority and the Government of PEI to authorize design and construction of a new health centre to serve East Prince and Summerside. The new hospital will open in late 2003.
