

INDIA POLYTECHNICAL COLLEGE FACULTY TRAINING

To assist the Government of India in upgrading its educational institutions, the World Bank provided a loan for purchase of equipment and for the upgrading of training of faculty members for a series of polytechnical engineering colleges (post-secondary institutions).

OCL Group was retained by the Dept. of Continuing Technical Education, Dalhousie University, Halifax, NS (formerly part of the Technical University of Nova Scotia) to develop and deliver a one month course (150 hr.) on environmental impact assessment and environmental management to 18 visiting faculty members. Additional time was devoted to site visits throughout Nova Scotia. Additional training was provided by other faculty in air pollution, water pollution and water distribution.

Tasks included development of the 150 hour course, preparation of hand-out materials, planning for site visits to re-enforce information and testing.
