

CITY OF MONCTON ENVIRONMENTAL AWARENESS SEMINAR



During a study on the Jonathan Creek watershed, the lack of environmental awareness or training of City staff was identified as a significant concern to the public. Also staff required assurance of undertaking their duties with regards to “due diligence” and protection of the City from inadvertent environmental liabilities or penalties. **OCL Group** was retained to develop and deliver an Environmental Awareness seminar to City staff and Council. Staff included all outside workers; supervisors, middle management and senior management. City Council included the Mayor and councilors. A total of over 150 staff and City government participated in the seminar presented in units of approximately 40 staff per session.



Course content included: regulatory aspects (federal, provincial, municipal); best management practices; planning and impact assessment, environmental site assessment, environmental procurement; “green activities”; auditing and EMS; specific discussions on employee employment activities and concerns.
